



ShanghaiPRIDE, which began in 2009, is an annual festival that celebrates diversity. This festival is organized entirely by volunteers with the support of media, businesses, individuals, and foreign consulates.



We aim to raise awareness and visibility, and to promote self-acceptance and acceptance for the LGBTQ community through sports, cultural, educational and social activities. As a non-profit festival, we also encourage the community and partners to support LGBTQ-related projects and initiatives. ShanghaiPRIDE promotes cross-cultural exchange locally as well as with LGBTQ festivals across the globe.



In 2014, the ShanghaiPRIDE team was awarded "Shanghai Hero" by Time Out Shanghai magazine.



The festival has grown from eight organizers and a modest gathering of 3,000 attendees in 2009, to 30 organizers and 6,500 attendees in 2017 with over 30 different sports, social, and cultural events. We have come a long way, and although the journey ahead may continue to be long and uncertain, we are determined to stand together to face the challenges ahead. We have high hopes that one day we will not need Pride festivals because there will be acceptance.

The 2018 ShanghaiPRIDE Theatre Festival program "I Am Nezha" uses individual experience as an entry point into queer narratives from the Chinese world.
